Ornamental Grasses

Ornamental grasses look good almost any time of year, but during the fall season grasses seem to flush out their best color. Many grasses in our area are

warm season growers, growing in spring and summer, blooming in late summer and early fall, and are dormant in the winter. Their seedheads colors of red, gold, orange, purple, and blue can be more striking than the flowers. Grasses come in many different types such as tall grasses, short grasses, native grasses, aggressive growers, tufted grasses, mounded grasses, tight grouping grasses, arching grasses, upright arching grasses, creeping grasses, and more.

Ornamental grasses have become more popular as landscaping returns to a more natural look. These grasses are used in a variety of ways such as softening hardscapes, creating container gardens, ground cover, creating a privacy screen, create autumn interest, adding texture to landscapes, creating edging, and many more. You can use ornamental grasses in planting beds as a background for fall perennials like asters, mums, coneflower, and sedums. Ornamental grasses are superb for hiding fading foliage and for protecting bulbs from colder weather. They also work well in those "trouble" areas of your property for example, an area with little to no irrigation, an area with too much water, or an area that requires no maintenance.

We have been asked many times about ornamental grasses and what type will be best for different areas of a property. We have gathered a list of ornamental grasses for areas that may be helpful for you.
