## Consistency Starts with TRAINING

**Coastal Greenery recognizes that consistent quality begins with thorough training.** Training starts upon hire and continues throughout employment, covering company onboarding, department-specific tasks, licensing, and regular meetings.

New team members complete a weeklong onboarding called "Succeeding from the Start," which covers HR, safety, and equipment operation. After onboarding, they engage in job-specific training for 2-4 weeks under a team leader. Performance is measured through evaluations and field testing, ensuring ongoing development.

Monthly department training keeps teams updated on procedures, standards, and certifications such as Georgia Licensed Pesticide Applicator, Certified Irrigation Technician, and others. Team members are encouraged to pursue additional licenses and certifications to enhance expertise and maintain high service consistency.

Daily and weekly departmental meetings address current issues, safety protocols, and best practices. These meetings foster leadership opportunities and ensure all staff stay informed and aligned with company standards.

Overall, Coastal Greenery prioritizes continuous, hands-on training to drive quality, consistency, and client satisfaction.

**Perennials & Renewal Pruning. . . . . During March**

- All pruning may not be completed in 1 visit, but we aim to complete pruning according to the schedules listed above.


